- Developed a national strategic plan for health professional training;

- Supported the career development of over 200 university-based faculty specializing in alcohol and drug education and research;

- Established training standards for fellowship programs in addiction medicine in collaboration with the Center for Medical Fellowships in Alcoholism and Drug Abuse at New York University;
